Chris and Stacey - I think it's time to get legal counsel involved. Anticipating Switzer's next moves, if/when I respond (on letterhead), he's going to then object on the basis of expenditure of public funds. If not approved already, we should get a retainer agreement and fee schedule together for the Board of Commissioners to take up at the next meeting and approve. The agreement can cover an annual "not to exceed" clause, which would ensure that we are cleared regarding Switzer's potential objections to a case by case basis that we are trying to infringe on his citizen rights.
