TO THE CLERK OF THE COURT AND TO ALL PARTIES OF RECORD:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Plaintiff Corey Michael Switzer, pro se, hereby supplements the record in the above-captioned matter with the **unredacted version** of Exhibit P, previously filed in redacted form.

The unredacted exhibit consists of the January 9, 2026 email from Amanda D. Daylong to Chris Kemp and Stacey Harman, bearing the subject line “*Attorney Client Privilege Fw: January RICO Correspondence.*” This document is directly relevant to Plaintiff’s pending motions for summary judgment, to compel, and for sanctions, as it demonstrates:

1. **Consciousness of guilt / bad faith** – Ms. Daylong proposed a “retroactive retainer agreement” and an annual “not to exceed” clause to “ensure that we are cleared regarding Switzer’s potential objections on expenditure of public funds.”

2. **Ultra vires conduct** – The email confirms that the special deputy appointment and fee agreement were structured to avoid public scrutiny of taxpayer expenditures, outside the scope of legitimate PRA litigation.

3. **Coordination among County officials** – The email was sent to Chris Kemp (Chief Operating Officer) and Stacey Harman (Clerk to the Board), showing direct involvement of senior County staff in the scheme.

A true and correct copy of the unredacted email is attached hereto as **Exhibit P-Unredacted** (1 page).

Plaintiff respectfully requests that the Court consider this document together with all previously filed exhibits in deciding the pending motions.

Chris and Stacey - I think it's time to get legal counsel involved. Anticipating Switzer's next moves, if/when I respond (on letterhead), he's going to then object on the basis of expenditure of public funds. If not approved already, we should get a retainer agreement and fee schedule together for the Board of Commissioners to take up at the next meeting and approve. The agreement can cover an annual "not to exceed" clause, which would ensure that we are cleared regarding Switzer's potential objections to a case by case basis that we are trying to infringe on his citizen rights.
