On 04.05.2021, at approximately 17:45 hours, I was dispatched to a battery not in progress, which occurred at the Travelland Rv. The complainant, Cory Switzer advised that he was battered approximately 6-months ago by a male by the name of Troy Munstermann. Cory stated the owner of Travelland RV, Kevin Munstermann (Troy's brother) made an agreement with Cory after he had been battered by Troy, that if there was no police report filed, and no charges pursued then the company would take care of the doctor's bills, and dentist bills.

Cory continued to explain the incident that had taken place approximately 6-months ago. He stated the following in summary. That he had done a few favors for Troy, and Troy's unidentified girlfriend. After helping out Troy, Cory realized that his wallet was missing. Cory said that he doesn't misplace things, and has never lost his wallet, leading him to believe that Troy had stolen it. Cory also said that he believed Troy's girlfriend stole one of his financial transaction cards.

Cory said that he confronted Troy about it, when Troy lost his temper and punched Cory once in the mouth. Cory explained that when Troy punched him, it had busted his two front teeth. Cory said that Troy only punched him one time. Cory said that other employees told him to call the cops, and Cory elected not too. Cory said that he spoke with the business owner, Kevin, and Kevin stated that he would fire his brother (Troy) for punching Cory, and would take care of his medical bills. In doing so, the agreement between the two parties was there would be no police report filed, and no charges pursued.

Cory said that when he initially went to the hospital, the RV company (Kevin) had initially paid for his bills. Cory said that in the months to come, he was distanced from the employees at the business, and ultimately fired. Cory said that he is fed up with it, and he now wants to pursue charges as the civil agreement they made had fallen through.

I later was able to contact Troy via cell phone contact, who stated the following in summary. I asked Troy if he remembered an incident that took place months ago at his old place of employment. Troy was quick to acknowledge that he knew what I was talking about. Troy could not believe that this was getting brought up, as he thought it had already been taken care of.

Troy said that he had gotten fired from Travelland RV in wake of the incident. Troy said that the incident started as Cory began accusing him and his girlfriend of stealing his stuff. Troy said that he told Cory that he didn't steal his things, and in return Cory called Troy's girlfriend a "Pill Popper". Troy said that Cory called his girlfriend a, "Pill Popper" and Troy in return punched Cory once in the mouth. Troy continued by saying that he has since started working for his brother Kevin, to repay him for having to pay Cory's medical bills.

I advised Troy I would be in touch with him in the near future.

I also advised Cory that I would follow-up with him in the near future as I would be off for the next 3-days.

I will attempt follow-up with Kevin in the near future.

On 04/07/2021 at approximately 1030am, I met with Cory Switzer outside the police department. He had called and asked to speak to me. I saw that he had made a battery report on 04/05/2021 with Ofc. Lines as well. I spoke with Mr. Switzer who said he did wish to speak to me about the incident. He said that he has lots of evidence on a hard drive that would corroborate his events of when he was punched by a subject named Troy while working and on the premises of Travelland RV on Sept. 8th, 2020. He said he had a verbal agreement with Troy's father, who owned the business to pay for Cory's teeth being knocked out if he didn't pursue charges. They apparently agreed on this but in November, Cory was fired and his medical bills are not paid for.

Cory also told me he has Asperger Syndrome which is a form of autism and after he was battered but before he was fired, the employees at Travelland RV would call him a retard because of him having Asperger's and that did not happen prior to the battery. Cory also told me when he was battered by Troy, there were 5 witnesses/employees who saw it happen and he could give us their names.

Cory showed me his mouth which appeared to have no teeth. He said two teeth were knocked out when he was punched by Troy after calling Troy's girlfriend a pill-popper after he believed she stole his wallet after a trip to Oregon. Subsequent to those teeth being knocked out, the dentist recommended removing two more. Cory felt that he was fired, treated improperly due to his Asperger's and his medical bills were not taken care of as agreed and he wanted to pursue battery charges.

I told Cory that Ofc. Lines handled the initial call and according to his report, he would be doing follow up as he was on his 3 days off. I asked Cory if he would save the evidence he had until Ofc. Lines got back so there were no chain of custody issues and I was also not sure what evidence Ofc. Lines had at this point. Cory said that would be fine. I advised Cory I would send Ofc. Lines and email to contact him Friday night when he comes to work to get the rest of this information.
