Mr. Switzer,

We are not denying your request to inspect public records, and we are not claiming an exemption. We conducted a search, and **there were no records responsive to your request**. You asked for communications about you that occurred between Rep. Mitchell and certain other persons. We found no such records in our search, which was based on search terms that you provided. We would claim an exemption only if we found responsive records but believed they were exempt from disclosure pursuant to law. Here, we're not holding back any records. We simply did not find any.

Despite my opinion that the Facebook thread is not a public record, Rep. Mitchell nevertheless authorized us to disclose it. You have it, and if you want a third party to certify it, perhaps someone at Meta can help you. But it is not a record of the Legislature or LSO, and we can't certify it. I'm in no position to attest to its authenticity.

I understand this might be frustrating, and if you believe we're misapplying the law, you might have legal recourse. However, that is something you'd need to discuss with your own lawyer. You're not my client, and I can't advise you.
